

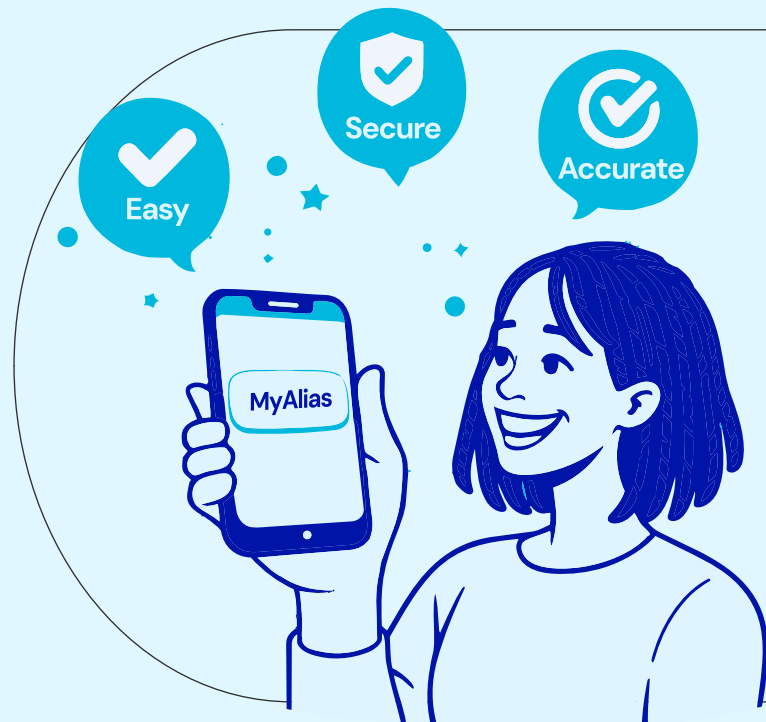
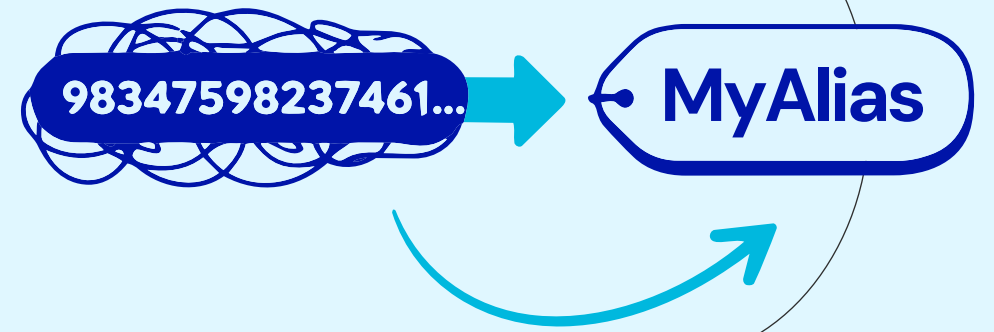


Aliases in BiMPay

What Is An Alias?

An alias is a simple identifier – like a nickname – that you can use instead of your full banking details when someone is sending you money.

It's a stand-in (a proxy) for your real account number.



Why Are Aliases Useful?

Aliases make payments:

- ✓ **Easier** – no having to remember long account numbers
- ✓ **Safer** – no sharing sensitive info
- ✓ **More accurate** – fewer typing errors from entering complex information

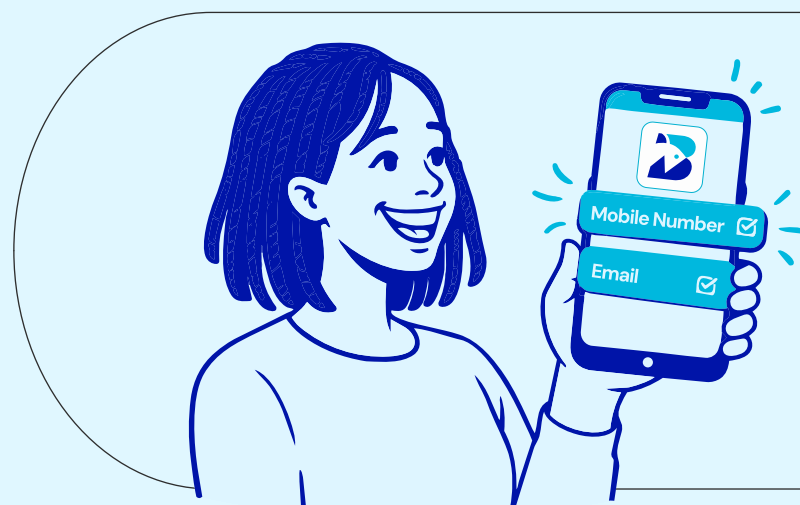
It's convenience *and* peace of mind.

What Can I Use As An Alias?

With BiMPay, your alias can be:

- Your mobile phone number
- Your email address
- Your national registration number (for individuals)
- Your business registration (TAMIS) number (for businesses)
- Or, in some cases, a unique nickname you choose

Plenty of options – all easy to remember.



Wallet Users

If you use the BiMPay e-wallet:
Your mobile number and email automatically become your default aliases.

They're ready to use right away.

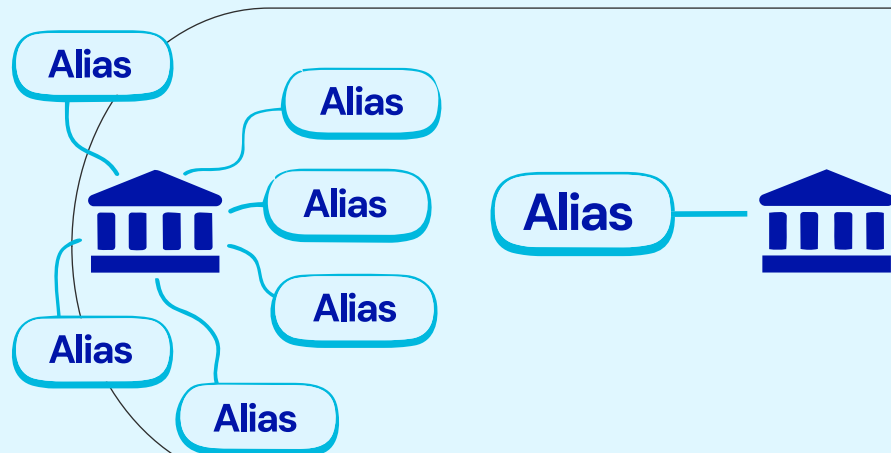
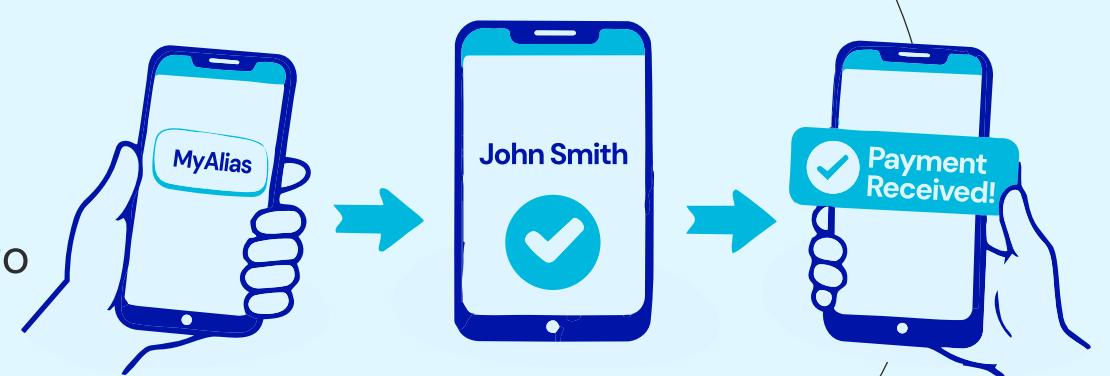
How Aliases Work

When you create an alias, BiMPay links it to your bank account or wallet in a **secure proxy management system**.

So when someone pays you using your alias, BiMPay:

- 1 Looks up the alias and matches it to your account
- 2 Shows them the name on the account and asks them to confirm it's you
- 3 Sends the money, which you'll receive in 10 seconds

You don't have to do a thing.



Alias Rules You Should Know

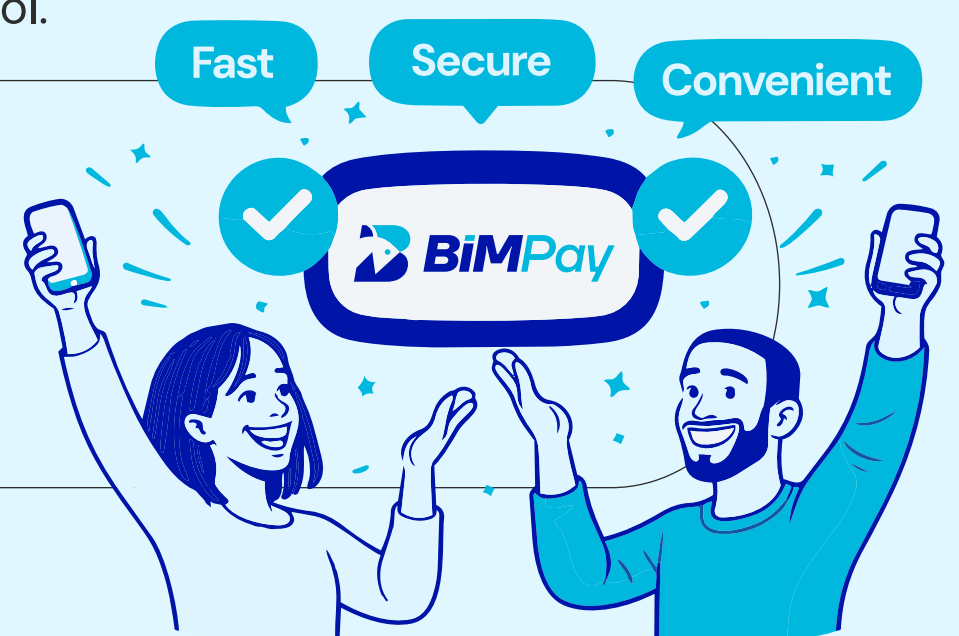
- ✓ You can have **multiple aliases** for one account
- ✗ But **one alias can point to only one account**
- ✓ You can update, suspend or delete an alias at any time

Simple, secure, and in your control.
